The Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) project will make up 30% of your final course grade for your agriculture class. This project is designed to give you the opportunity to learn more about agriculture in general, an agriculture career field, or a leadership field of your choice. The project is meant to be worked on throughout the entire semester. A parent/guardian and supervisor/employer/manager will be required to sign this informational sheet explaining the requirements for your SAE project. You will also be responsible for signing this sheet after reviewing.

YOU MUST COMPLETE:

- At least 10 hours of work on your project
 - o Log sheet for hours is located online
 - o You must print one and get your hours signed by your supervisor/employer/manager AND your parent/guardian
- At least 10 pictures of your project
 - o YOU MUST BE IN AT LEAST 3 OF THEM
- One mandatory journal entry on the AET website per week (class time provided on Fridays)
 - o Journal entries need to review work that you have completed that week
 - o One entry must list your major end goal for this project and the steps you plan to reach that end goal
- Final powerpoint or poster board presentation overviewing your project due at the end of the semester (you will present them in class as part of your grade)
